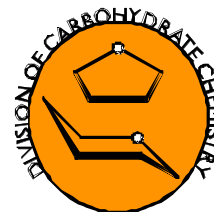




**234<sup>th</sup> ACS National Meeting, Boston, MA**

### **Present:**

- f. The meeting will be the week before the 15<sup>th</sup> New Orleans Carbohydrate Symposium (NOCS), which has been on hiatus since the death of Margaret Clarke in 1998. Xavier Miranda from the Sugar Processing Research Institute presented details on the event, which will be in the style of a Gordon Research Conference. The dates for the NOCS are April 10–

12 with all talks to be given on April 11 and 12 at the Dauphine Orleans Hotel. It is hoped that scheduling the NOCS immediately following the ACS meeting will increase participation and help revive this meeting.
